BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN NURSING (B.Sc NURSING - 4 Years)

B.Sc Nursing is an undergraduate programme that prepares graduates to afford great carrier opportunities and high salary options. It is a pre requisite for care provider, teacher, researcher and administrative roles in various health care settings. The annual intake is 100.

ELIGIBILITY

- Candidates who have passed Higher Secondary Examination conducted by Board of Higher Secondary Education, Kerala or Examination equivalent there to as approved by Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur. Candidate should have separate minimum pass mark for Physics, Chemistry and Biology and 50 % marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology put together.
- 2. Candidate belonging to SC/ST category needs only a pass in the qualifying examination. However the rules and regulations stipulated by the Government of Kerala and Kerala University of Health Sciences from time to time will be applicable.
- 3. Candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from outside Kerala State shall produce equivalency of qualifying examination from the Kerala University of Health Sciences along with the applications.
- 4. Candidate shall be medically fit.
- 5. Applicant should have completed 17 years of age as on 31.12.2023. Upper age limit is 35 years as on 31.12.2023.

SELECTION

- 1. Candidates to 50% of seats for BSc Nursing Course will be filled up by the Govt. from state merit and the remaining 50% of seats will be filled up by the management of the college of which 35% of total seats will be filled up from the rank list for management quota and 15% of the total seats will be filled up by the management from Non Resident India NRI quota rank list.
- 2. Applications will be received **online** only for the management and NRI quota seats and separate rank list will be prepared for each quota. Any other mode of submission of application shall not be entertained and will be rejected.
- 3. Rank list prepared on the basis of marks obtained by candidates for Physics, Chemistry and Biology put together at the final year of the qualifying examination will be published in the college website. Incase of a tie in the total marks computed for ranking, candidates with higher marks in Biology/ Chemistry/Physics/total marks in the qualifying examination (Plus One and Plus Two together) / percentage of marks in English / age of the candidate/alphabetical order of the name respectively will be placed higher in the ranking.
- 4. Print out of the online application along with the supporting documents and proof of the Application fee remittance to be submitted to the Principal by post/Person on or before the due date.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

 - a. Sponsorship certificate on Rs. 200 stamp paper attested by notory.
 - b. Copy of relevant pages of the Passport containing Visa Details attested by Embassy / Gazetted Officer
 - c. Employment Certificate (with salary) of the Sponsor attested by Embassy.
 - d. Relationships Certificate from Revenue Authorities
- 10. The students of B.Sc Nursing are required to refer to rules and regulations of Kerala Nurses and Midwives Council, Indian Nursing Council, Kerala University of Health Sciences and Government of Kerala issued from time to time.
- 11. Admission is made only to the First year of the course and not directly to any higher class. Application for admission to higher classes or for migration to other colleges will not be entertained.
- 12. Students are required to submit Application for Hostel Admission at the time of interview. Admission to the hostel will be as per the provision of statutory body.

FEE STRUCTURE

- Students are liable to pay the tuition fee and special fee as fixed by the Government of Kerala at the time of admission.
- 2. The tuition fee and special fee for the first year has to be paid at the time of Admission. The tuition fee and special fee for subsequent years has to be paid before the fourth working day of the beginning of each academic year. Fine will be levied from defaulters who are not paying the fee in the prescribed time period.
- 3. Fee for College Union, Sports day, Cultural day, etc. has to be paid separately.
- 4. Hostel fee has to be paid at the beginning of each academic year or paid monthly before 5th of each month.
- 5. Mess fee in the hostel has to be paid before the 5th day of each month.
- 6. Fee remitted will not be refunded if course discontinue after the closing date of admission. On discontinuation of the course after the closing date of admission students are liable to pay liquidated damage to the college as ordered by the Admission and Fee Regulatory Committee and court of law.

- 6. Undesired activities such as taking of alcohol, drugs, tobacco products, smoking, using vulgar language and indulging in violence are strictly prohibited.
- 7. Use of mobile phones are strictly prohibited in the Classroom, Laboratory and Clinical Area.
- 8. Students should be utmost regular and punctual in their class room session, practical, field work sessions and other academic exercises. They are required to attend all the allotted working periods in each of the prescribed subjects.
- 9. No student will be admitted to the class room unless he/she is well equipped with the required instruments and necessities as and when instructed by the concerned faculty members.
- 10. Students should complete their academic requirements in the same year before the succeeding examination.
- 11. Proper and prior permission must be obtained from Principal before organising and conducting tours, picnic or other group activities.
- 12. Students should refrain damaging college property.
- 13. In case of any breakage/loss of hospital or college property, it shall be made good promptly, either individually or collectively.
- 14. The management, following due enquiry procedure, has the right to expel any student whose conduct and character are not satisfactory.
- 15. Any student acting in violation of any of the rules and regulations of the campus or found disturbing the peace in campus as well as off campus will be prosecuted by the head of the institution reserving the right to suspend/dismiss the student without any explanation.
- 16. Student communications intended for higher authorities must be submitted through the Principal.
- 17. Students should wear their Identity Cards always.
- 18. Student using own vehicles should get permission from the concerned authorities by submitting copy of license and vehicle registration certificates.
- 19. Certificates will be issued only on the specified days.
